The club has not arranged any events since the general assembly March 7. 2020.

A few days later the country was almost closed due to the restrictions caused by Covid-19.

Later in the spring we announced, that all planned events had to be put on hold.

As I turned out, this also included the general assembly to be held before the end of March 2021.

Since the start of 2021 planning has been very difficult. All of our events have to be announced with a long notice, but introductions as well as terminations of the various restrictions have appeared with a very short notice. The cashier has announced that he does not want to continue in the position. The chairman has more than two years ago told that he wanted to resign, and as mentioned above, Kristoffer has left the club.

With the board in this state, we urgently encourage any club member, who would like to participate in the future management of the club to sign up as candidate for the coming board.

Though the club activity has been on hold, the board members hope that the members of the club each and every one separately has had a couple of good sailing seasons since March 2020.

We are looking forward to seeing as many of you as possible again in 2022.
